Registration Form

Registration

Barring special situations, the last date for registration will be August 13. We will encourage mail and on-line registration. On-site registration will be August 12-13. Cindy will be the chairperson for registration. She will organize staff and other details. Craig and Tony will be on-site to solicit volunteers for the season. Cindy will find out what the final date is that the Treasure Coast League allows roster changes.

Dee will assist in getting supplies ordered as Frank is away for most of the summer. We need balls, pumps, disc (cones). Net repairs will happen closer to the season. We also need first aid kits for each coach, and a larger one for the concession stand. Fred will approach Publix for free kits before ordering from a vendor.

Tony will look at them and order remaining needs. Next season the equipment manager will organize signage.

Long-Range Plans

We need to continue to form a vision for the future. We can consider player benches, lightning detection, shed/slab in the woods to store nets and benches, and so on. We should not limit ourselves by finances, as if we have a viable project we will search out the financing and county approval. Tim may be able to get us a few free wood benches from the hockey rink if we decide they are a good idea.

Trainers

Steve is continuing to research options. He welcomes input and recommendations from all.

Comp

TCSL is recommending that comp players sign an addendum/contract that helps prevent poaching. The intent is that if they commit to a club, then leave, they would not be able to return to that club for at least 2 years. The Board agreed to the recommendation of the HSSC Comp reps to support TCSL in proceeding with this process.

Dee and Hank will work with Nick to be sure the try-outs are staffed.

Sponsor/Fundraising Plan

We will proceed with the following concepts:

- Approach local individuals and businesses to solicit sponsorships
- Sell bricks to place around the concession stand, replacing dead plants
- Have a pre-season party at \$5 a kid/\$10 a family (to be finalized later) - will have some inflatables, water balloon targets, and the like, keeping in mind the different age groups.
- Combine with a silent auction.

Signage for sponsors will have different/larger placement than in the past.

Fred and Tony will have sponsor sign sizes and prices available at next meeting.

Board Recognition

We will work to develop ideas about who/how/when to recognize pivotal volunteers.
